

PROIV Version 9 End of Life Schedule

Version 9.0 Production Release	- January 2018
Version 9 End of life notification	- 30th April 2022
Version 9 End of life	- 30th April 2023

- Entering version 9 end of life notice period on 30th April 2022
- Version 9 will be end of life and receive no further maintenance or service release updates past 30th April 2023
- Zellis will continue to provide support and maintenance services up until the end of the notice period
- Existing contractual commitments will be honoured if they pass beyond 30th April 2023
- Zellis will not enter into any new Version 9 maintenance contracts (excluding bronze) extending beyond the 30th April 2023

Autumn 2022 Release Advance Notices

As part of the autumn 2022 maintenance release we give notice that PROIV Version 9 will be updated to a minimum requirement of Java 11. As a consequence the following notices are made:

Windows and Linux distributions will be updated to include the Microsoft Java Runtime Environment.

Solaris 10 will no longer be supported.

IBM AIX 7.1 will require the IBM Semeru JDK 11 as a pre-requisite.

Licence Options leading up to End of Life

From May 1st 2022

- **Zellis will not sell any more perpetual Version 9 licences by default. Any variations to this will require internal Zellis approval for exceptional circumstances.**
- **Version 9 maintenance renewals (Silver and above) will not be extended past 30th April 2023**

Beyond End of Life – 30th April 2023

Specifically for contracts extending past 30th April 2023

Where Zellis has contractual commitments to provide support services for PROIV Version 9 beyond 30th April 2023 we will continue to do so.

Service releases will be issued as necessary but no more frequently than monthly at the end of the month.

All service releases will be cumulative and based on the 9.1000 maintenance release, there will be no further maintenance releases of version 9.
